5) If you order by phone please remember to PRESS 1 to divert to the ordering voicemail or PRESS 2 if you have query and need to speak to a dispenser.

Please try to avoid ordering by speaking to the Receptionist as they do not have knowledge of medications and are extremely busy dealing with other enquiries.
